- 1). Answer: c)

However, Nooyi will remain the Chairman of the company until early 2019 to ensure a smooth and seamless transition. President Ramon Laguarta, 54, will succeed the 62-year-old Nooyi effective Oct. 3, becoming Pepsi's sixth CEO. Nooyi will remain as chairman until early 2019.

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has approved continuation of the Centrally Sponsored Umbrella Scheme of Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats (CSS-IDWH) beyond the 12th Plan period from 2017-18 to 2019-20. The Scheme consists of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger (CSS-PT), Development of Wildlife Habitats (CSS-DWH) and Project Elephant (CSS-PE). The total outlay is Rs. 1731.72 crore as central share (Rs. 1143 crore for Project Tiger, Rs. 496.50 crore for Development of Wildlife Habitats and Rs. 92.22 crore for Project Elephant) from 2017-18 to 2019-20.

7). Answer: d)

The Canara bank opened a portal to claim education loan interest subsidy for the financial year 2017-18. The Portal will be opened till 28, 2018. This is under the Central sector interest subsidy (CSIS) scheme implemented by the Union Ministry of HRD which was started in 2009. Full interest subsidy is provided to the eligible students for the course period plus one year for loans up to Rs. 7.5 lakh and This is applicable to students from an Economically Weaker section having parental income upto Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum.

A Japanese team has developed a "space elevator" and will conduct a first trial in September, 2018. The test equipment will be launched on an H-2B rocket being launched by Japan's space agency. The test involves a miniature elevator stand-in – a box just 6 cm long, 3 cm wide, and 3 cm high. It's the world's first experiment to test travel between two mini satellites in space.
