1) Answer: d)

Market Stabilization Scheme (MSS) is a monetary policy intervention by the RBI to withdraw excess liquidity by selling government securities in the economy. It is used to withdraw excess liquidity or money from the system by selling government bonds.

2) Answer: c)

RuPay is India's indigenous card scheme created by the National Payments Corporation of India. It was conceived to fulfill RBI's vision to offer a domestic, open-loop, multilateral system which will allow all Indian banks and financial



institutions in India to participate in electronic payments. It is made in India, for every Indian to take them towards a "less-cash" society.

3) Answer: d)

The maximum interest rate is given on Fixed Deposit Account. Fixed deposit is a financial investment instrument offered by banks & NBFCs wherein investors can deposit money and get a high rate of interest than a normal savings account. It is also known as term deposit. The tenure of FDs varies from 7 days to 10 years.

4) Answer: d)

Reserve Bank of India advised all public-sector and select private and foreign banks to appoint Internal Ombudsman (IO) as an independent authority to review complaints that were partially or wholly rejected by the respective banks. RBI has reviewed the arrangement and issued revised directions under Section 35 A of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 in the form of 'Internal Ombudsman Scheme, 2018'. All Scheduled Commercial Banks in India having more than ten banking outlets (excluding Regional Rural Banks) are required to appoint IO in their banks.

5) Answer: c)

The Reserve Bank has identified four broad areas for targeted policy intervention to improve the existing payments system — competition, cost, convenience and confidence. The central bank noted that cardbased transactions will see a sixfold increase in the next three years propelling the Indian economy to a 'cash-lite' one.
