Answers :

1) Answer: c)

Repo rate is the rate at which the central bank of a country (Reserve Bank of India in case of India) lends money to commercial banks in the event of any shortfall of funds.

Repo rate is used by monetary authorities to control inflation. The current repo rate is 5.75%.

2) Answer: e)

Balance of Payments is defined as the total volume of transactions undertaken by a country in the international account over a financial year. It is mainly categorized under two heads and they are current account and capital account.

It summarizes all transactions that a country's individuals, companies and government bodies complete with individuals, companies and government bodies outside the country. These transactions consist of imports and exports of goods, services and capital, as well as transfer payments such as foreign aid and remittances.

3) Answer: b)

Section 7 of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 empowers the government to issue a direction to the RBI on policy issues. The government has invoked Section 7 which has never been used before. The law provides for the government to give instructions to the central bank based on the dialogue between the two.

4) Answer: c)

Banking Outlet is a fixed-point service delivery unit for a Domestic Scheduled Commercial Bank, Small Finance Bank and Payment Bank. It is manned by either bank's staff or its Business Correspondent where services of acceptance of deposits, encashment of cheques/ cash withdrawal or lending of money are provided for a minimum of 4 hours per day for at least five days a week.

IndusInd Bank launched 'IndusInd Bank Nexxt Credit Card' – India's first interactive Credit Card with buttons. It empowers customers with a choice of payment options such as EMI, Reward Points or Credit at the push of a button, on the card, at the

Point of Sale. It also makes redeeming Reward Points or opting for EMI payments convenient.
