1) Answer: b)

The Net Demand and Time Liabilities or NDTL shows the difference between the sum of demand and time liabilities (deposits) of a bank (with the public or the other bank) and the deposits in the form of assets held by the other bank.

Brown label' ATM are those Automated Teller Machines where hardware and the lease of the ATM machine is owned by a service provider (Third Party), but cash management and connectivity to banking networks is provided by a sponsor bank whose brand is used on the ATM.

Reserve money ( $M_0$ ) = Currency in Circulation + Bankers' Deposits with RBI + 'Other' Deposits with RBI. It is also called as high powered money, base money and central bank money. All these names suggest that reserve money represents the base level for money supply or it is the high powered component of money supply.
