The Vijaya Stambha is an imposing victory monument located within Chittorgarh fort in Chittorgarh, Rajasthan, India. The tower was constructed by the Mewar king, Rana Kumbha, in 1448 to commemorate his victory over the combined armies of Malwa and Gujarat led by Mahmud Khilji. The tower is dedicated to Vishnu.

An axillary bud is a sprout that develops in the axil of a plant, which is the angle formed by the upper side of the stem and an outgrowing leaf or branch. These embryonic shoots develop exogenously from the outer-cortex layer of the plant at the axillary intersection and eventually grow into new stems.

Phloem tissue helps in the transport of food. Food is transported in both upward and downward directions. Transport in xylem requires physical forces such as transpiration pull.

Green plants are autotrophic and synthesize or make their own food by the process of photosynthesis. They do this with the help of carbon dioxide and water in the presence of sunlight. Their corresponding modes of nutrition are known as the autotrophic and heterotrophic mode of nutrition.

A pyrometer is a type of remote-sensing thermometer used to measure the temperature of a surface. Pyrometers are suited especially to the measurement of moving objects or any surfaces that cannot be reached or cannot be touched. Temperature is a fundamental parameter in metallurgical furnace operations.
