In 1973, 239 banks from 15 countries got together to solve a common problem, how to communicate about cross-border payments and it led to formation of SWIFT. SWIFT went live with its messaging services in 1977

'Lake Sports Complex' was earlier known as Lake Club and was set up in 1961 making it one of the oldest sporting clubs of the city. It has a large club house spread on 10 acres campus. Now it has been renamed as Lake Sports Complex. The Lake Sports Complex rowing course was the venue of the 1989 Senior Asian Rowing Championship and the 1994 Junior Asian Rowing Championship.
