





Answers:

1) Answer: A

On 25th October 2019, Government of India organized the 4th Ayurveda day. The day is being celebrated by Ministry of AYUSH as Dhanvantari Jayanti falls on the day. Dhanvantari is a Hindu god who cures diseases. The Ministry of Ayush will distribute "National Dhanvantari Ayurveda Award" the award comprises of trophy and a cash reward of Rs 5 lakhs.



2) Answer: E

Vice President, M. Venkaiah Naidu lead the Indian delegation. Theme for Summit-'Upholding the Bandung Principles to ensure concerted and adequate response to the challenges of the contemporary world'. NAM is a forum of 120 developing world states that are not formally aligned with or against any major power bloc. After UN, NAM is the largest grouping of states globally.

3) Answer: B

The Malabar River Festival is South India's only extreme adventure competition organized on behalf of Kerala Tourism by DTPC Kozhikode and Madras Fun Tools.

4) Answer: B

The 'Samudrayaan' project undertaken by the NIOT, Chennai, is in line with the ISRO's ambitious 'Gaganyaan' mission of sending an astronaut to space by 2022. The 'Samudra yaan' is a part of the Ministry of Earth Sciences' pilot project for deep ocean mining for rare minerals.

5) Answer: C

For minimum KYC complaint, e-wallet service providers asks for user's mobile number and a single government identification number to authenticate the account. However, full KYC requires a more detailed verification procedure. Normally, PAN card and proof of address are among the prerequisites for full KYC.


7) Answer: D

It is a statutory authority under the provisions of the Aadhaar Act, 2016. It functions under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), with the mandate to issue UID or Aadhaar, a 12-digit random number to all residents of India to eliminate duplicate and fake id entities. It is founded by the Government of India 28 January 2009 and is headquartered in New Delhi.

8) Answer: C

Sharp deceleration in manufacturing output and subdued farm sector activity pulled down India's gross domestic product (GDP) growth to over six-year low of 5 per cent in the April-June quarter of 2019 – 20.

9) Answer: D



It is the exchange of information between countries without having to request it. It aims to reduce global tax evasion. It is to be carried out under Common Reporting Standard (CRS). CRS is agreed global standard for it which has been approved by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in 2014.

10) Answer: D

The partnership comes after the Reserve Bank of India announced the progressive Co-Origination Policy in September 2018, allowing banks and NBFCs to co-lend to a wider set of enterprise owners. This is the first such Co-Origination partnership of Central Bank of India with an NBFC.

11) Answer: A

Population of Assam is 3.09 crores and the population Density of Assam is 398 per sq km (greater than that of China). Between 1901 and 2011, the population in Assam has increased 9 times.

12) Answer: E

This joint India-France air exercise is aimed at enhancing interoperability level of French and Indian crews in air defence and ground attack missions. Aircraft like Rafale, Sukhoi 30, Mirage 2000, C-17 Globemaster etc will participate.

13) Answer: B

Pune is called "Queen of the Deccan" because in earlier days Pune was a salubrious green city with a "hill station like atmosphere".

Answer: A

The 1400-ft -long bridge on Shyok River, situated in Sub-Sector North at 14,650 ft and christened after 'Lion of Ladakh' Col Chewang Rinchen. Col Rinchen was born on November 11, 1931 at Sumur village, Nubra Valley in Ladakh region, and is known as the 'Lion of Ladakh' for his extraordinary acts of courage in defending Leh and Partapur sector.

15) Answer: C

On October 21, 1959, twenty Indian soldiers were attacked by the Chinese troops in Ladakh. This altercation between the troops led to the death of ten policemen.

Ever since the incident, October 21 is celebrated as Police Commemoration Day in remembrance of the martyrs.

Last year, Narendra Modi inaugurated India's first national police museum in Delhi on the occasion of Police Commemoration Day 2018.
