and Small enterprises, who are generally considered to be a high risk lending, especially in the absence of collateral.

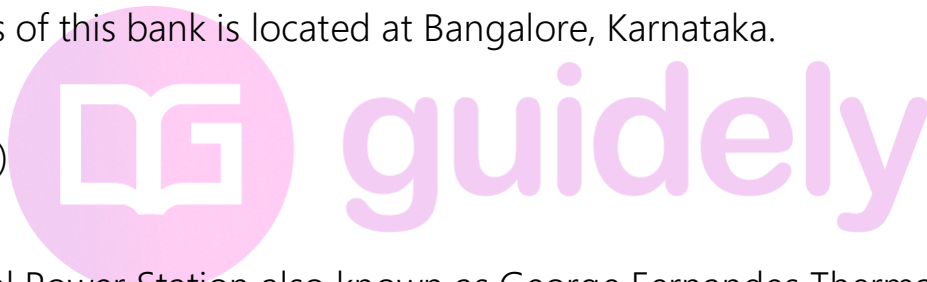
