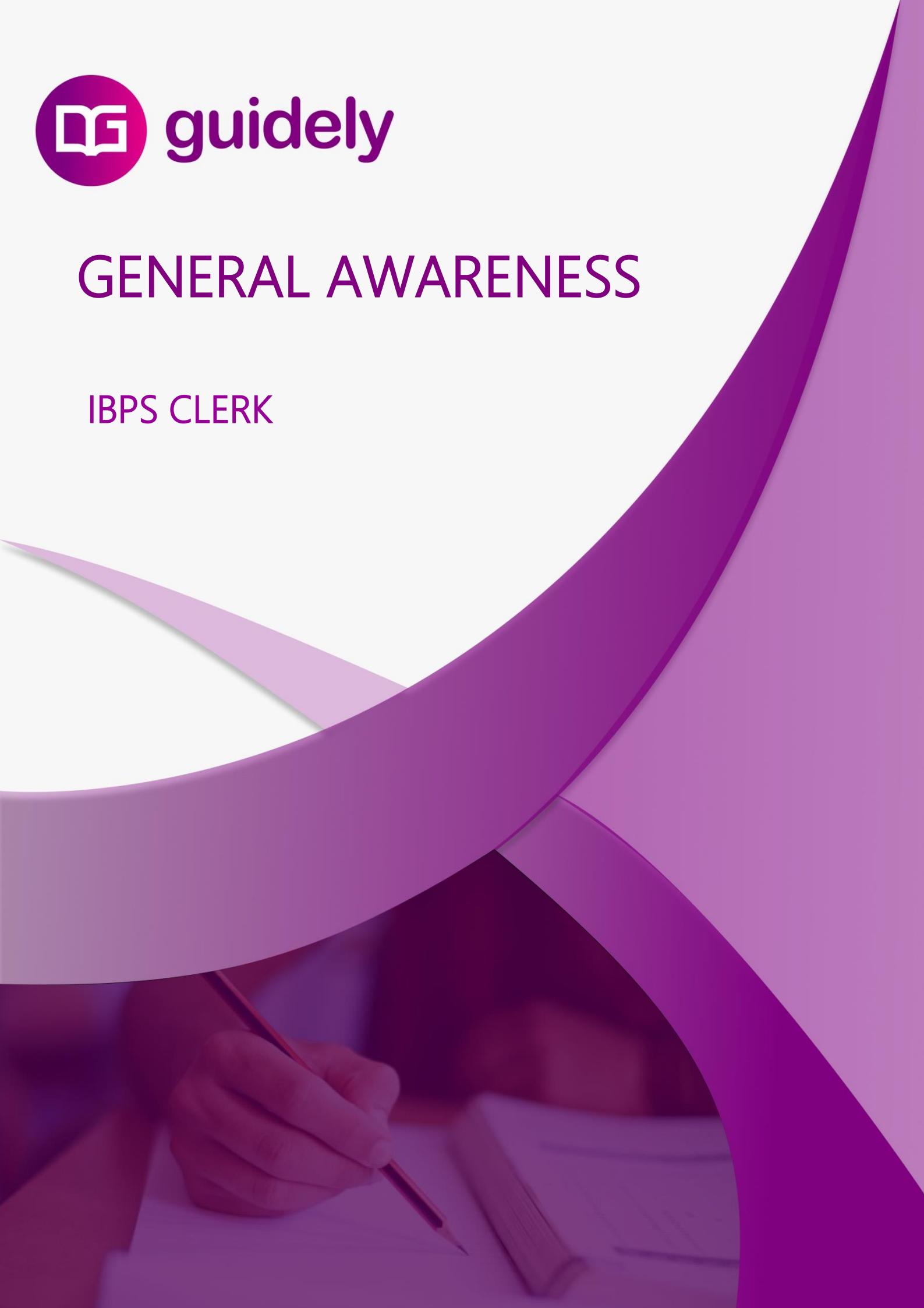

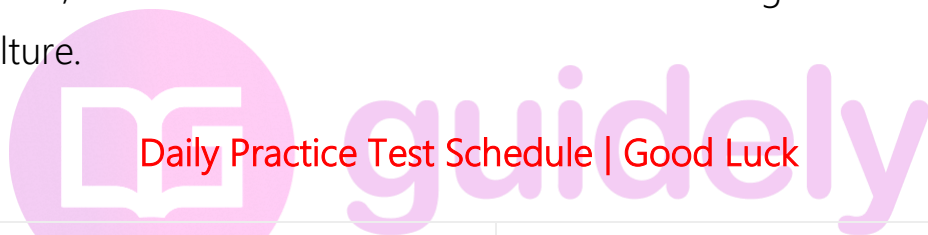
India, he was earlier a member of the Fifteenth Finance Commission of India and India's Sherpa to the G20.
