- **Global Parents Day or Parents Day** is observed on the 1st of June every year to celebrate the unique bond of children and parents & the theme of 2021 is **Appreciate all parents throughout the world**.
- **World Milk Day** has been observed on June 1 each year since 2001 & established by the FAO to recognize the importance of milk as a global food & The theme and focus of **World Milk Day 2021** is: “**Sustainability in the dairy sector**”.
- Every year **June 2** is celebrated as **International Sex Workers** day to honour and recognises the exploited working conditions of sex workers & its 2021 theme was “**Access to Justice**”.
- **Telangana Day** commonly known as **Telangana Formation Day** has been observed annually on **2 June** since 2014, commemorating the formation of the state of Telangana.
- In **April 2018**, the **United Nations General Assembly** declared **June 3** as **International World Bicycle Day** to develop a culture of cycling for basic transportation, commutation, and strengthening physical and mental health.
- **International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression** is a United Nations observance held on **June 4 every year** to acknowledge the pain suffered by **children** throughout the world who are the **victims** of physical, mental and emotional abuse.

- **World Environment Day** is celebrated annually on **5 June** and is the United Nations' principal vehicle for encouraging awareness and action for the protection of the environment & the theme of 2021 **World Environment Day** is “**Reimagine. Recreate. Restore.**”.
- The **UN General Assembly** declared **5 June** as the “**International Day for the Fight Against Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated Fishing**”.
- **World Day against Speciesism** is marked on **June 5** every year, to stop discrimination based on species membership.
- **World Pest Day (World Pest Awareness Day)** is observed on **June 6** every year to create awareness of how **pest** management helps preserve the quality of life for people.
- **UN Russian Language Day** is observed annually on **June 6**. The event was established by the **United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)** in 2010.
- **World Food Safety Day** is observed every year on **June 7** to draw attention and inspire action to prevent, detect and manage food borne risks & the 2021 theme is ‘**Safe food today for a healthy tomorrow**’.

BANKING**RBI**

- **Reserve Bank of India** announced its **bi-monthly monetary policy rates** have been reviewed. Projected GDP rate for FY 22 – 9.5%; Repo rate

– 4%; Reverse Repo rate – 3.35%; Marginal Standing Facility Rate – 4.25%; Bank Rate – 4.25%; Cash Reserve Ratio – 4%; Statutory Liquidity Ratio – 18%.

- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has extended the bank license of the **Rupee Cooperative Bank** for another **three months until August 31, 2021**.
- The **RBI** has cancelled the licence of **Shivajirao Bhosale Sahakari Bank, Pune** as the lender does not have adequate capital and earning prospects under the provisions of the **Banking Regulation Act, 1949**.

ADB

- The **Asian Development Bank** (Mr. Takeo Konishi, Country Director of ADB's India Resident Mission) and the **Government of India** (Rajat Kumar Mishra, Additional Secretary, and Department of Economic Affairs in the Ministry of Finance) has signed a **\$2.5 million project readiness financing (PRF) loan** to support project preparation and design activities to **upgrade major district roads in Sikkim**.

OTHER BANKING NEWS

- **HDFC Bank** has installed mobile **ATMs across 50 cities in India**, which can be used for **over 15 types transactions by customers**.
- **ICICI Bank**, the first bank in **Asia-Pacific** and the second globally, has tied up with **SWIFT** to offer a facility that helps overseas partner banks to send

instant remittances on behalf of their customers to the beneficiary in India.

- **Mumbai based Bharti AXA Life Insurance** has entered into a bancassurance partnership with **Saharanpur based Shivalik Small Finance Bank** for the distribution of its life insurance products through the 31 branches and **digital network across the country**.
- The **National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD)** has sanctioned **Rs 254 crore** to set up **two mega piped drinking water supply projects** in **Odisha** under the **Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF)**.
- Public sector banks will be offering **unsecured personal loans between Rs 25,000 to Rs 5 lakh** to salaried, non-salaried and pensioners for **Covid treatment**.
- **ICICI Lombard** has tied up with **Microsoft** to strengthen and automate the quality control processes.
- **Edelweiss Retail Finance Ltd** has partnered with the **Central Bank of India** for **priority sector lending (PSL)** to **micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs)**.
- **HDFC ERGO General Insurance** announced its partnership with **Visa** to provide **curated insurance covers** namely **'Business Suraksha Classik and My:Credit Personal Accident Insurance group policy'** for **Visa's business card holders**.

- Paytm (Backed by investors like SoftBank Group, Ant Group and Berkshire Hathaway) is targeting a **valuation of \$25 billion to \$30 billion**, 1.5-1.8 times the current valuation of \$16 billion.
- **The SEBI (Mr. Ajay Tyagi, Chairman, SEBI) and Luxembourg's CSSF (Claude Marx, Director General, CSSF)** have entered into a bilateral Memorandum of Understanding **for mutual cooperation and technical assistance.**
- The Financial Stability and Development Council (FSDC) has constituted **the first of its kind inter-regulator panel** to address the regulatory challenges posed by the fintech industry.
- **SEBI** enhanced the overseas investment limit for an individual mutual fund house to **\$1 billion**, up from **\$600 million**, at present.
- **Satin Creditcare Network** has become the first MFI to introduce the **UPI AutoPay** with help of **NPCI and HSBC India** as its banking partner.
- **HDFC Bank** announced its plans to **become carbon-neutral by 2031-32** to reduce its emissions, energy & water consumption.
- **HSBC** has exited the retail and small business banking market in the United States to focus on corporate and investment banking in India
- Central Bank of India has allotted **280,53,76,972 equity shares** to the government on a preferential basis for **Rs4,800cr** capital infusion in the bank.
- **Paytm Payments Bank** will launch **physical debit cards issued by Visa & Currently Paytm offers physical debit cards by Rupay, and virtual debit cards by Visa** to customers.

- **24th BIMSTEC** (Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation) Day Observed on **6th June 2021** by the BIMSTEC member countries which consist of Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Myanmar and Thailand.
- **World Brain Tumor Day** is observed on **June 8** to raise awareness for the disease.
- **World Oceans Day** is an international day that takes place annually on **8 June** & the theme for **World Oceans Day 2021** is 'The Ocean: Life and Livelihoods'.
- The **World Accreditation Day (WAD)** is celebrated on **9th June every year** to highlight as well as promote the role of accreditation in **trade & economy** with the theme of **Accreditation: Supporting the Implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).**

- The 13th International Level Crossing Awareness Day across the globe on **10th June** to create awareness on the importance of level crossing safety & the theme of ILCAD 2021 is “Distraction” with the motto, “Distraction kills!”
- The **World Day Against Child Labour** is an **International Labour Organization-sanctioned** holiday **first launched in 2002** aiming to raise awareness and activism to prevent child labour with the **theme** of World Day Against Child Labour is “**Act now: End child labour.**”
- **International Albinism Awareness Day** is celebrated annually on **June 13** to celebrate the human rights of persons with albinism worldwide and the **theme** of 2021: **Strength Beyond All Odds.**
- **World Blood Donor Day (WBDD)** is held on **June 14** each year and the **theme** For 2021: “**Give blood and keep the world beating**”.
- **World Wind Day** also known as **Global Wind Day** is observed every year on **15 June 2021** to discover and spread awareness about **wind**, its power and the possibilities it holds to change our energy systems.
- **World Elder Abuse Awareness Day** is observed on **June 15** every year to raise **awareness** about **abuse** and neglect of **older** persons and the **current theme** of **World Elder Abuse Awareness Day** is '**Access to Justice**'.

RBI

- The **RBI imposed a penalty** aggregating to Rs 6 crore on Bank of India and Punjab National Bank for **contravention of norms, including one related to 'Frauds – Classification and Reporting'**.
- **RBI** extended the risk-based internal audit (RBIA) system to select housing finance companies to enhance the **quality and effectiveness** of their internal audit system.

WORLD BANK

- The **World Bank** has approved a **USD 500 million Raising and Accelerating Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) Performance (RAMP) Program** to help boost India's **MSME sector**.

OTHER BANKING NEWS

- **PayNearby** in collaboration with IndiaFirst Life Insurance Company Limited has launched an insurance solution '**Poorna Suraksha**' for its retail community to ensure the safety and security of

PayNearby's 15+ lakh retail partners across 17,500+ PIN codes.

- **Bank of Maharashtra** has emerged as the **top performer** among public sector lenders in terms of loan and deposit growth during the financial year 2020-21.
- The **State Bank of India** has launched a **collateral-free unique loan offering** – 'Kavach Personal Loan', under this scheme, the bank will provide loans up to **Rs 5 lakh** at an effective interest rate of **8.5 per cent per annum** for **5 years**.
- **Federal Bank** has expanded its **collaboration with Oracle and Infosys** to provide improved customer experience through **Oracle CX (Customer Experience)** platform.
- Narendra Modi government may soon finalize plans to **sell Centre's stake** in **Central Bank of India** and **Indian Overseas Bank (IOB)** to privatize two state-run banks as unveiled by **Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman** in her Union Budget speech 2021.
- The **Yamuna International Airport Pvt Ltd** has received the **final credit sanction** for **Rs 3725 crore** from the **State Bank of India** for the development of **Noida International Airport** at **Jewar, Uttar Pradesh**.
- **Indian Bank** has partnered with **Fisdom** to offer a comprehensive suite of wealth management products and services to the bank's ten crore customers.

- A subsidiary of **Tanla Platforms**, **Karix Mobile** has deployed a conversational banking solution, **WhatsApp Business**, for **Axis Bank**.
- Public sector banks have sanctioned **95% of the total loans** under **PM SVANidhi scheme** which aims at providing street vendors loans of up to **Rs 10,000** for one-year tenure to restart their business.
- The Central bank of India has entered into a strategic co-lending partnership with **Indiabulls Housing Finance** and **IIFL Home Finance** to offer housing loans under **priority sector** to homebuyers at competitive rates.
- **NITI Aayog** has made a recommendation that the **Indian Overseas Bank (IOB)** and **Central Bank of India** are the two candidates that are considered for **privatisation exercise**.
- **SEBI (Securities and Exchange Board of India)** barred **Franklin Templeton Asset Management Company** from launching certain debt schemes for **two years** and fined **Rs.5 crore** for violating regulatory norms and asked it to pay **Rs 517 crore** to wind up six debt schemes
- **BSE Administration & Supervision Ltd (BASL)** has received recognition from **Sebi** to administer and **supervise investment advisors (IAs)** registered with the regulator, and commenced its operation from **June 1**.

- **Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay** has launched its new **Centre for Digital Health** to focus on driving academic programmes, research and industry collaboration in Digital Health.
- **Gujarat Maritime Board (GMB)** will set-up the country's first international maritime services cluster at GIFT City to enhance the

competitiveness and self-sufficiency of India in the maritime sector.

- **Policybazaar** has got approval from regulator **IRDAI** to undertake insurance broking, a development that will help the company augment business and expand a bouquet of services.

- **The Reserve Bank of India** Issued Norms for **FATF Non-Compliant Jurisdictions’** Investment in payments system operators (PSOs).
- RBI has revoked the deposit-taking status of **Dewan Housing Finance**; it is the first financial services firm to go for bankruptcy proceedings.

ADB

- The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** approved a **USD 250 million loan to Bangladesh** to improve the inclusiveness and responsiveness of the country’s social development and resilience program.
- The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** has approved a **USD 484-million loan** to improve transport connectivity and road maintenance in the **Chennai-Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor (CKIC)** in Tamil Nadu.

BANKING

RBI

- The RBI imposed penalties of **Rs 23 lakh** on **three cooperative banks**, including **Mogaveera Co-operative Bank Limited, Mumbai**, for contravention of various norms.
- The Reserve Bank extended the regulatory restrictions on **Punjab and Maharashtra Cooperative (PMC) Bank** by another six months **till December 2021** to enable the completion of its takeover by **Centrum Financial Services**.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** imposed a total penalty of **Rs 8 lakh** on **three Maharashtra-based**



co-operative banks for deficiencies in regulatory compliance.

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) came out with dividend distribution guidelines for non-banking finance companies (NBFCs) **in order to infuse greater transparency and uniformity in the practice.**
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** was **second only to Turkey** in terms of reserves transferred to the government as a percentage of GDP for the fiscal year 2020-21.
- The Reserve Bank has launched the 2020-21 round of its **annual survey** on computer software and information technology enabled services (ITES) exports.

WORLD BANK

- The **Government of India, Government of Mizoram** and the **World Bank** have signed a \$32 million **Mizoram Health Systems Strengthening Project** to improve management capacity and quality of health services in Mizoram, particularly for the benefit of under-served areas and vulnerable groups.
