Answers :

1) Answer: d)

On the basis of this Narasimham committee's recommendations, Regional Rural Banks Act 1976 was passed by an Act of Parliament. Prathama Bank was the first Regional Rural Bank of India to be established with sponsorship from Syndicate Bank of India.

2) Answer: c)

Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) is not a subsidiary of Reserve Bank of India. The Securities and Exchange Board of India is the regulator for the securities market in India. It was established in the year 1988 and given statutory powers on 30 January 1992 through the SEBI Act, 1992.

3) Answer: e)

The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC) — was the first bank to introduce the ATM concept in India in 1987, The ATMs installed were from Diebold. The first cash machine that enabled withdrawal of money from a customer's bank account was installed by Barclays Bank in the UK in 1967.

4) Answer: e)

The maximum free withdrawal per month for Basic Savings Bank Deposit Accounts is limited four. The withdrawals include ATMs and other modes like RTGS, NEFT, clearing, branch cash withdrawal, online transfer, standing instructions, equated monthly instalments (EMIs) etc. If the withdrawal limit exceeds, BSBD accounts would be converted into a regular savings account. The customer cannot credit more than ₹1 lakh in a BSBD account in a year and can't have more than ₹50,000 in it at any time. Also, the total debits by cash withdrawals and transfers in a month cannot exceed ₹10,000.

5) Answer: e)

Current Account Deficit is the full form of CAD. The current account deficit is a measurement of a country's trade where the value of the goods and services it imports exceeds the value of the goods and services it exports.

6) Answer: c)

The river Ganga after traversing whole of its journey gets drained into Bay of Bengal. The mouth of River Ganga forms the world's largest delta, Sunderbans, which was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1997. Ganga River Basin

runs almost 2,150 kms long, with over 20 minor and major connecting tributaries spanning over 7 Indian states.
