- Global Family Day is an annual celebration observed on January 1stof every year with the theme "One
 Day of Peace" which was then observed on the first day of every year to welcome the New Year.
- World Braille Day is observed every year on 4 January to celebrate the importance of braille, a form of communication and written language for people who are blind and visually challenged.
- In 2002, Born Free USA in coordination with the Avian Welfare Coalition launched the first annual National Bird Day to promote avian awareness.
- The **Journalist Day** is observed by the Maharashtra state government on **6th January** every year. This day was celebrated in **memory of late journalist Balshastri Jambhekar**.
- The World Day of War Orphans is observed on January 6 every year. The day was initiated by France
 based SOS Enfants En Detresse (SOSEED), a sponsorship program for orphans.

- The government **extended** the deadline to file **income tax return (ITR)** for individuals by 10 days to **January** 10, 2021. Prior to that the deadline was **December 31**, 2020.
- The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has extended the deadline for FASTags for all vehicles in India till February 15, 2021.
- The government approved a multi-modal logistics and transport hub (MMTH) at Greater Noida in Uttar Pradesh.
- The DRDO observed the 63rd Foundation Day of its establishment on January 01, 2021.
- Minister of State for External Affairs Muraleedharan launched the Global Pravasi Rishta portal and mobile
 App, to connect with Indian Diaspora across the world.

- The Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) has formally announced the final approval for Oxford AstraZeneca and Bharat Biotech vaccines against the coronavirus disease (Covid-19) for emergency use.
- The Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) released Data on Police Organizations. The BPR&D has been publishing the Data on Police Organizations (DoPO), annually, since the year
- Home Minister Amit Shah released the inaugural issue of the National Police K-9 Journal in New Delhi. It
 is the first such publication in the country on the subject of Police Service K9s, Police Dogs.
- The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has capped the amount of transfatty acids (TFA) in oils and fats to 3% for 2021 and 2% by 2022 from the current permissible limit of 5%.
- Indian Railways' South Western Railway zone will start operating train services from Bengaluru city station to the newly built KIA, Devanahalli Railway halt station.

- Delhi Government Department of Art, Culture, and Language has set up a Tamil Academy to Promote the language and culture of the southern state of Tamil Nadu.
- North Zone Cultural Centre, Patiala (Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India) and Jammu & Kashmir Academy of
 Art, Culture & Languages, Jammu is jointly organizing National Folk Dance Festival from December 26-28.
- Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade is organizing Udyog Manthan a marathon of focused sector-specific webinars for promoting Quality and Productivity in Indian Industry.
- **Digital channels of Prasar Bharati** have registered more than **100 percent growth** in 2020, with Pakistan being the second highest digital audience for Doordarshan (DD) and All India Radio (AIR).
- The Centre has decided to form a committee to protect the language, culture and land of Ladakh and ensure citizen's participation in the Union Territory's development.
- The Standing Committee of **National Board of Wildlife (SC-NBWL)** in its **60th meeting** has approved the advisory for management of **Human-Wildlife Conflict (HWC)** in the country.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the 306-km New Rewari-New Madar section of the Western

- India will begin its two-year tenure as a non-permanent member of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC).
- On new year eve, Australia has changed one word in its national anthem to reflect "the spirit of unity" and the country's Indigenous population.
- The US Congress has passed the Malala Yousafzai Scholarship Act which will expand the number of scholarships available to Pakistani women to receive higher education under a merit and needs-based programme.
- India has sent over six tons of relief material to Fiji for its cyclone-affected people, reflecting its close ties
 with the island nation in the South Pacific.
- The 51st edition of International Film Festival of India (IFFI) will be held in Goa from January 16 to January 24, 2021.
- British Prime Minister Boris Johnson cancelled his Republic Day visit to India later this month, citing the
 need to oversee the Covid-19 pandemic response at home. The development comes as Britain began its
 third Covid-19 lockdown.
- The first ever wooden satellite could be launched from Japan in 2023. The Japanese firm Sumitomo
 Forestry and Kyoto University have joined forces in the aim of developing a wooden satellite that would burn up more readily as its lifespan ends, without leaving debris or waste behind.
- The year 2020 was the eighth warmest year on record since nation-wide records commenced in 1901, the
 India Meteorological Department (IMD).
- India has called for introspection within the UN Security Council over the lack of representation of African countries among its permanent members.
- India and France are scheduled to hold their annual Strategic Dialogue in New Delhi.
- A new approach for surveying African elephants using satellite imagery and artificial intelligence (AI) could
 help in solving some of the present challenges in the conservation of the species.
- The World Bank has projected an economic growth rate of 6 percent for Bangladesh for the FY 2020-21.

- The **Assam Legislative Assembly** passed the repeal provincialisation of Madrassa Bill, 2020 to abolish all government-run Madrassas in the state and convert them to general schools.
- Madhya Pradesh Government is Organizing an exhibition called Raag-Bhopali is being organized to promote Zari-Zardozi crafts of Bhopal.







- India and Asian Development Bank (ADB) have signed a USD 231 million loan to augment electricity
 generation capacity in the State of Assam through construction of a 120 MegaWatts hydroelectric power
 plant that will enhance availability of electricity for households.
- **Jharkhand** is set to replace the **Prime Minister's insurance scheme** for farmers with its own crop relief scheme **Kisan Fasal Rahat Yojana**.
- Admiral Karambir Singh, the Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS) visited INS Dwarka, Indian Navy's forward operating base at Okha, Gujarat, on New Year's Eve.
- All shops and commercial establishments employing ten or more people in Karnataka are now allowed to operate on a 24x7 basis, the state government.
- Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has inaugurated a migrant worker cell of Surat Municipal Corporation
 (SMC) at Udhna based iLab in Surat.
- In Madhya Pradesh, 'Launch Pad Scheme' is being started for boys and girls coming out of child care institutions and having completed 18 years of age.
- On January 6, 2021, **Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath's** government will launch an initiative named 'Kisan Kalyan Mission'
- This is mainly for double the income of farmers of the state.
- Government signed two loan agreements of USD 646 million with New Development Bank for upgrading
 State Highway Network and District Road Network in Andhra Pradesh.
- Justice Hima Kohli has become the first woman Chief Justice of Telangana High Court following her swearing-in.
- The two-day Asian Water bird Census-2020 commenced in Andhra Pradesh under the aegis of experts from the Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS), covering at least two dozen sites, including Coringa Wildlife Sanctuary, Kolleru Lake and Krishna Sanctuary.
- In Uttar Pradesh, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has ordered to increase the stipend amount with immediate effect as a new year gift to students who are doing internships after completion of MBBS and BDS course.
- Madhya Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh have become the first group of states to complete three out of the four citizen-centric reforms stipulated by the Ministry of Finance.

- National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) announced that RuPay has partnered with RBL Bank to launch an innovative payment solution for Indian merchants – RuPay PoS in association with
- The Reserve Bank of India has constructed a composite Digital Payments Index (DPI) to capture the
 extent of digitisation of payments across the country.
- State-run Bank of Baroda announced the launch of banking services on messaging platform
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to introduce the Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) system for all
 payment transactions of value ₹50 crore and above undertaken by entities (non-individuals) via RTGS and
 NEFT.
- IDBI Bank announced the launch of video KYC account opening (VAO) facility for savings bank accounts.
- The Government of India and the Government of West Bengal and the World Bank signed a \$105 million project to improve the inland water transport infrastructure in Kolkata, West Bengal.

CURRENT AFFAIRS: ECONOMY

- Goods and Services Tax collections for December Rs 1.15 lakh crore, the highest ever since the implementation of the nationwide tax in July 2017.
- The World Bank estimates India's growth to recover to 4% in FY22, as the rebound from a low base is offset by muted private investment growth given financial sector weaknesses.

- In Jammu and Kashmir, the Union Territory Administration signed a historic Memorandum of
